- Equips students with certifications that enhance their attractiveness to potential employers
- Increases student employability & skill levels
- Complements other aspects of our comprehensive Transition Services curriculum (including career interest surveys, vocational coursework, résumé & portfolio creation, job interview skills, community-based mentorships/internships, on-campus simulated employment opportunities)

## Partnership Features



- High Road has been operating in Prince George's County for 15 years already a successful collaboration
- High Road is the only non-public in PGC partnering with the college on this program
- Students from all High Road Schools in both MD & DC can qualify and participate
- Training programs delivered both at High Road Schools (mostly Largo location, but sites will vary) and on PGCC campus
- Trainings conducted by certified instructors provided PGCC
- Program flexibility allows for meeting the needs of individual schools and not interfering with students' educational coursework & regular academic curriculum





## Curriculum Components



- All participating students commence the program with required
   Career Essentials curriculum:
  - ♦ 26-Hour Customer Service Course
  - ♦ 18-Hour Microsoft Word 2013 Mastery Course
  - This certified course provides foundational background & skills transferable to any field
- Three certification-bound vocational tracks currently available:
  - Hospitality
  - Child Care
  - IT Academy
- Additional vocational tracks will be added as Workforce Development Program progresses





# HOSPITALITY





### **General Program Information:**

- Hosted by PGCC's Hospitality, Tourism & Culinary Arts Institute
- Offers training & certifications in Front Desk, Maintenance, and Food & Beverage
- Class limit of 5 (minimum) to 15 (maximum) students to ensure personalized attention & instruction
- High Road is on PGCC Hospitality Advisory Board, allowing our Transition Coordinators to network with businesses in the field & facilitate job opportunities for our students
- Multi-Component "Hospitality Express" Job Training Program:







### **Four-Component Program:**

- 1 START (Skills, Tasks, and Results Training):
  - Curriculum developed by American Hotel & Lodging Association
  - (1) Provides specific skills training en route to professional certifications;
     (2) prepares students for entry-level lodging positions; and (3) promotes confidence & positive work ethics
  - Divided into three units: Hospitality Express I, II & III covering numerous specialty areas (e.g., reservationist, bell attendant, guestroom attendant, laundry attendant, PBX operator, etc.)
  - Students must complete all three units
  - Upon passing final exam, certification granted by American Hotel & Lodging Association
  - Following 90 days of employment in entry-level hospitality position, program graduates are eligible for additional professional certifications from American Hotel & Lodging Educational Institute





### **Four-Component Program:**

- 2 ServSafe Food Handler Program:
  - Covers five key areas: (1) Basic Food Safety; (2) Personal Hygiene;
    - (3) Cross-Contamination & Allergens; (4) Time & Temperature; and
    - (5) Cleaning & Sanitation
  - Successful completion of course & exam results in national certification from the National Restaurant Association
- 3 Customer Service Training Curriculum:
  - Teaches students how to demonstrate knowledge and skills & incorporates core values of brand awareness and of how customer service workers affect company profits/reputation and customer satisfaction
  - Successful completion of course & exam results in national Customer
     Service & Sales Certification from the National Federation of Retail





### **Four-Component Program:**

### 4 Bring Your A Game:

- Adds the element of essential values, not just learned skills, to successful employment
- Uses cutting-edge methodology to develop seven foundational work ethic behaviors: (1) Attendance; (2) Appearance; (3) Attitude; (4) Ambition; (5) Acceptance; (6) Accountability; and (7) Appreciation
- Based on proven learning model developed by nation's best workforce development & education professionals
- Designed to establish lasting change in the workplace to meet managers' demands & expectations
- Successful completion of course & exam results in certification from the Center for Work Ethic Development

### Track #2: Child Care



### **General Program Information:**

- Hosted by PGCC's Continuing Education Offerings: Early
   Childhood Education & Child Care
- For students interested in working in the day care industry & other agencies/organizations providing services to children
- Courses meet the Maryland Child Care Credential requirements established by MSDE OCC (MD State Department of Education, Office of Child Care)
- Credentialing courses organized into topic areas that cover the "core of knowledge":
  - ♦ Curriculum
  - ♦ Child Development
  - Health, Safety & Nutrition
- ♦ Community
- Professionalism
- Special Needs





### Track #2: Child Care



#### **Lead Teacher Certification:**

- In addition to more general areas of child care certification, students can earn more specific Lead Teacher Certification
- This 90-hour certification program consists of:
  - 45-hour Child Growth & Development course (which covers child development from birth to age 12)
  - 45-hour Curriculum Development course for <u>at least</u> one other age group:
    - Infant/Toddler (from birth to 2 years old)
    - Preschool Curriculum/Activities (ages 3–5)
    - School-Age Curriculum (ages 6–12)
- Lead Teacher Certification also requires 9-hour Communication
  Skills for Child Care Providers course

## Track #3: IT Academy



### **General Program Information:**

- Hosted by PGCC's Continuing Education Offerings: Computers & Information Technology: MS-Office Application
- Students in this program can earn continuing education certificates in:
  - Entry-Level Administrative Assistant
  - Microsoft Office Suite (including MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook, Publisher)







## Track #3: IT Academy



### **Further Opportunities:**

- For those students who are well-suited to a career in the computer field and who wish to continue their education through PGCC's IT curriculum, options beyond the admin assistant and MS Office certificates include certifications in:
  - Help Desk Technology
  - Web Design & Management
  - Networking
  - Computer Hardware
  - Information Security





## Additional Information



- Student selection & eligibility will be determined by High Road Schools
- Program frequency, length & scheduling will be jointly determined by HRS & PGCC
- High Road will provide staff on the premises of trainings to address any behavioral issues that may arise
- Certification programs can be mixed & matched to best meet HRS needs
- Students struggling to pass certification exams will receive additional support, like modifications to help them complete the program and the chance to retake exams
- Other options being explored: PGCC's QUICK START Program and PGC Public Schools Choices & Pathways option
